




User Experience	<p>Here we are evaluating only the chinesepod website as well as the service, and the app has serious technical issues that need to be addressed. Most of the messages on the website were answered, which is great, customers will continue to pay attention to us only when their problems are solved. But I think it's also good to look at other sites like raddit as well. most of the questions about chinesepod on Reddit go unanswered. In these comments, some people say that the course distribution is too confusing and they don't know the order of the classes, I suggest that the main flow of the course and the design concept can be put on the homepage, so that students can easily set up the course direction for themselves. Some people say we have too much English in our course lectures and make sure each lessons in the right section on our webpage.</p> <p>Also, I think it's essential to set up reminder emails that can be sent to customers before every Chinese holiday/discount.</p>

IDEA BOX

Pimsleur's program is not as extensive as ours, but they have a lot of **REVIEW SECTIONS** to learn from.

For example, the voice coach, which allows us to practice while learning and also hear our own pronunciation, is very helpful to our speaking, after all, the biggest goal of practicing a language is to be able to speak. Meanwhile, they also made some games, such as this screenshot, to quickly match the pinyin and its English meaning.
